Curriculum Content Objectives

To receive credit, students will perform 100% of the following content objectives:

1. Define basic blueprint drawing components
2. Identify and use fabrication drawing abbreviations and standard welding symbols
3. Identify and calculate dimensions and tolerances
4. Fabricate weldment from print to industry standards

Assessments

Students must achieve no less than 80% or B for a final grade in the high school course to receive ACC.
