Course Description

This course addresses the continuing application of tools and techniques of sound pickup, amplification, recording, editing, distribution, and output as they apply to the craft of narrative video production. The use of digital audio equipment and software as well as analog audio equipment is covered. (2 credits lecture/ 2 credits lab)

1. Audio editors and other careers in narrative video production
2. Audio terms and concepts
3. Edit music files
4. Edit music loop clips
5. Edit sound effects clips
6. Record voice audio
7. Record sound effects
