Curriculum Content Objectives

To receive credit, students will perform each of the following content objectives:

1. Demonstrate safety
2. Layout basic wall stud location
3. Identify platform-frame construction & components
4. Identify & use measuring/layout tools
5. Layout and construct basic floor frame
6. Layout and assemble basic wall openings
7. Check wall section squareness
8. Identify layout and construct basic roof framing

Assessments

Students must achieve no less than 80% or B for a final grade in the high school course to receive ACC.
