## Curriculum Content Objectives

To receive credit, students will perform 100% of the following content objectives:

1. Demonstrate safety
2. Identify roofing materials
3. Apply roofing materials
  - Roof edging
  - Ice and water barrier
  - Roofing felt
  - Starter strip
  - Roofing materials (*i.e., steel, fiberglass or wood*)
  - Ridge caps
  - Roof venting and flashing

## Assessments

To receive ACC, students must achieve no less than 80% or B for a final grade in the high school course.
